METHODS OF MEASUREMENT OF FINANCIAL EFFICIENCY AND PRACTICAL ASPECTS OF DECISION MAKING IN BANK STARTUPS IN THE CONTEXT OF BANKING SECTOR IN POLAND

Abstract: Banking market is still developing and new investment projects in banks emerge. Banks are the institutions in which management, to a large extent, is based on the application of modern methods of modelling and planning. The seminar is an attempt to capture the development trend that banking experiences in Poland and to present methods of evaluation and support of managerial decisions, which can also be successfully applied in new banking projects, understood as investments aimed at creating a dynamic development of a new bank. Banking activity is highly targeted at a financial aspect, the focus is put on measures of financial viability. Tools of financial evaluation of new credit products as well as a practical aspect of their application in making managerial decisions will be described. Additionally, methods of measurement of financial efficiency in banks will be presented and particular attention will be paid to an aspect of decomposition of capital profitability ratio.
